Gordon Wins PH Award

Albuquerque City Health Department Director Larry Gordon has been selected for the Walter S. Mangold Award.

The annual award will be presented to Mr. Gordon and to Jerrold Michael of the US. Public Health Service at the conference next month of the National Association of Sanitarians.

Mr. Michael is a co-winner.

Given Only Once

The Mangold Award is given only once to any sanitarian. The award is made in honor of Prof. Walter S. Mangold, who has devoted more than 40 years to public health..

Nicholas Pohlit, executive secretary of the National Association of Sanitarians, said the award for Gordon designates him as one of the foremost leaders in the field of environmental health.

He said the award is given to the sanitarian who has done most toward the professionalization of the sanitarian and in providing a fit environment in which people may live.

Several Awards

Gordon has received several national awards since becoming health director for the city in 1955. Prior to that, he had been a district sanitarian and state sanitarian.

He is also a consultant to the Public Health Service and to Sandia Corp. in radiological health.
