Charge:

Assist/participate Executive Secretary/Treasurer transitions. (Immediate Priority)

Solicit, vet and recommend to the Board of Directors for approval, a qualified accountant (firm) to conduct a *simple financial review* for *IRS 501 (C) 3* and Form 990 compliance. The accountant (firm) should also make recommendations for process, bookkeeping, records retention and acquisition of software compatible with size and scope of Academy needs. (*Target April BOD vote.*)

Chair will provide a written and verbal Finance Committee Report for each Board of Directors Meeting.

Review and approve AAS Annual Financial Report. Chair will provide an electronic and verbal summary, including trend analyses at the Annual Business Meeting.

Chair will provide Committee recommendations as to how the Board might improve Academy's financial position at the Annual Business Meeting.
